## MESSAGE FROM OUR CHAPLAIN

Dear friends,

This is my third attempt of finalizing this message to you. While last week we were advised by our Spanish Catholic colleague to cancel all services and therefore planned to hold a small service of HC at the Chaplaincy House & Centre this coming Sunday, we have heard back from him just now: Services can take place again with 75% capacity and all safety measures in place. So: Until further notice, we will hold our September Services in church in PdC as well as in Playa Blanca – please see page 4 for dates and times.

Thankfully we have now finalised our next Living Room Service and so we can come together virtually as well with our remote friends.

I am delighted with the initial response to our appeal on the Chaplaincy House and Centre.

Several sales agents have been instructed on the former Chaplaincy House in Puerto del Carmen and viewings are already being undertaken. Our appeal to Friends and the wider Church community established through the virtual service has produced nearly €19k which is so encouraging. I am heavily engaged in submitting applications to Charitable Trusts and the Diocese and I am confident that we will have encouraging news in the autumn. Until we have a definite sale figure on No 37 we cannot finalise our appeal target but the enthusiasm and energy being expended and demonstrated is so positive.

I am so grateful for your wonderful support.

What has been so good is that many from our global congregation have made commitments to us and we are receiving support from those who ask us to channel support to our local communities. Sister Ana at Calor y Cafe, the homeless charity in Arrecife has been one of the recipients of this support, as is the initiative headed up by Dave Poxon in Playa Blanca.

Urgent further help is required and I would ask that if you are able you might buy the odd non-perishable items when shopping which can then be donated via the Chaplaincy Centre. We can arrange collection if you will kindly telephone me. Finally, let all of our work be held in your prayers and we long for the day when we can celebrate together without fear or anxiety. Stay safe and stay well.
