

REVEREND CANON ANDREA WILLS

will be with us together with her husband Charles from August 3rd to 24th and lead our services in Puerto del Carmen for 3 weeks while Fr Stan and Rosemary are going on their much-deserved vacation to see their families. Here's what Andrea shared with us to introduce her:

Fr. Stan and I have been firm friends especially since we were installed together as Canons of St. Mary's Cathedral, Tuam, Co. Galway in the Diocese of Tuam, Killala and Achonry.

I was ordained in 2009 for the non-stipendiary ministry, having been a Diocesan Reader for many years and involved in central church committees. I am now priest in charge of the Parish of Foxford, in Co. Mayo. I also take a monthly service in a hotel in the town of Claremorris. The church there, a beautiful building, closed for worship some 50 years ago, and now is the town library. I live at home with my husband Charles. We have three sons, two married and one engaged, and 3 grandsons and a granddaughter.

God niggled and nudged and so it was in middle age that I undertook the course of study of three years part-time in the Theological College in Dublin. Ministry is such a privilege.

Before ordination I was involved in Mothers' Union and I was a General Trustee and attended meetings regularly in Mary Sumner House in London. I have recently completed my term as Mothers' Union Chaplain in my own Diocese.

Charles and I have been coming to Lanzarote for over a decade. Mostly a week at a time.

Flights went from Knock Airport, which is near where we live, direct to Lanzarote weekly and it was wonderful to be able to leave the wet and windy west coast of Ireland and four and a half hours later arrive in the warm and sunny climate of Lanzarote. Unfortunately, at the moment there are no flights out of Knock to Lanzarote and we have to travel from Dublin which is a 3 ½ hours' drive. I look forward so much to meeting everyone and taking services for Fr. Stan when he and Rosie have a well-earned break.
